### **Find Your Roles and Obligations Under CLP Regulation and How to Comply with CLP regulation**

CLP stands for the Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 on the Classification, Labeling and Packaging of substances and mixtures. CLP introduces the United Nations globally harmonized system (UN GHS) for classification and labeling of chemicals into Europe. CLP entered into force on 20th January 2009.

Besides REACH, CLP regulation is another piece of chemical regulation you need to comply. This article includes how to classify and label your products, how to submit C&L notifications and how to prepare REACH&CLP compliant SDS.

### **Submit Your C&L Notifications Today**

According to CLP regulation, EU manufacturers and importers (or groups of manufacturers or importers) who place a hazardous substance on the market, shall **notify** certain information, in particular the substance identity and the classification and labeling of that substance to ECHA (C&L notification) before **3 Jan 2011**.

Downstream users, non-EU companies and distributors (including retailers) do not need to submit C&L notifications. However, non-EU companies may ask their REACH Only Representative to submit C&L notifications in the name of their importers by filling in the following application from:
